

ICCM Best Paper Awards 2015

One of the main objectives of ICCM is to encourage and recognize young researchers, especially postgraduate students, for their dedication and contribution to computational methods and its relevant fields. The ICCM Best Paper Award will be carried out in ICCM2015 for the 2nd time, after it was established in ICCM2014.

- Maximum number of awards is confined within 5% of total presentations in the conference.
- Official certificates signed by the conference Chairmen and Selection Committee Chairman will be presented to the awardees.
- Eligibility requirements:
 - A full paper presented in the ICCM2015 conference with a student (Postgraduate or Undergraduate) as the first author and presenter. The supervisor's contact information should be provided, if he/she is not a co-author
 - The student should indicate her/his application for the award when the full paper is submitted;
- Selection process:
 - Selection committee members assess the full paper to shortlist.
 - Selection committee members assess the shortlisted presentations.
 - Full discussion of the shortlisted candidates will be carried out in the committee to determine the final awardees. Note that the decision will be the final and no appeal will be entertained.
